Psalm 19:1-4 "The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no speech nor language Where their voice is not heard. Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their words to the end of the world." All aspects of the creation, including every living thing show design, purpose, wisdom and power. The reality of a Creator obvious and evident to every one of our senses. There have

been many studies on the different species on earth, including with the latest technology. Scientists claim we are not close to discovering them all, though the number of them is already in the millions, including microscopic and nonmicroscopic species. All with amazing attributes and abilities that can not be explained with the totally unproven "theory of evolution", including instinct, emotions, the senses, etc. There are literally millions of examples of design in these many living species. Including in insects, fish, animals, flowers and vegetation, mammals, reptiles, birds, humans, invertebrates etc. When we begin contemplating the awesomeness of this creation, we do have divine help. The creation itself, the Bible,

our brains and senses, science and often overlooked common sense. Why the Bible, some may ask? The Bible has been truly documented by facts. Fact One, the Bible has been purchased an estimated six billion (6,000,000,000) times. Two, the Bible's truths have actual power to change and save lives, and has done so for countless millions of humans. Three, its a history book, including the history of the Jewish people, verified by archaeology, and secular historians, such as Josephus. Four, its an accurate description of the human condition and has the remedy for its ailment of sin. Five, fulfilled prophesy, hundreds of events foretold then fulfilled Romans 1:20 "For since the creation of the world His

invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse." All of life shows evidence of a Designer and Creator. There are other proofs of the Creators existence. The sun and moon, placed at just the right distances from earth, to sustain all of this interdependent life. The sun controls aspects of the climate and weather. Storms, temperature on land and of the oceans, wind, rainfall or lack of it etc. And seems to go in 11 and 22 year cycles that intensify or lesson these climate events. While the moons distance and pull of gravity control the tides, essential to life. Genesis 1:14-18 "Then God said,"Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens

to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; "and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth," and it was so. Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness.

And God saw that it was good."
He has also created His awesome irrigation system that takes care of His created life on earth. The sun evaporates the water from the oceans and seas. The water vapor then passes over the lands,

cools, condenses and falls to the earth as rainfall or snowfall, necessary for sustaining all life. Much of the moisture is then collected by thousands of streams then rivers. Which bring it back to the oceans and seas, repeating this cycle over and over, obvious design. Witness to the fact there is a Designer and Creator of it.

Ecclesiastes 1:7 "All the rivers run into the sea, Yet the sea is not full; To the place from which the rivers come, There they return again." It's unfortunate that in today's world, we have two versions of science. True science based on observable and factual evidence. And the untenable "science" based on speculation and agenda's. The main agenda of speculative science is to move

humans away from the reality of Creation, to the untenable evolution model. To not take in the obvious of that which our senses are telling us, but things as some would want them to be. To not be responsible to a higher power, and that we humans are on our own and in control, even though its obvious we are not. There are many well respected scientists in the past and present who have and do believe in creation. Their work and findings have been proven over and over again. Just a few of these; Newton, Pasteur, Kepler, Pascal, Mendel, Faraday, Boyle. Those findings confirm and support the truth of creation. There are also many modern day scientist's who believe in creation. Its a long list and we may not recognize their

names, but we can google it. Obviously this list is just a small portion of the ones in scientific fields over the years, that have and do believe in creation and not in evolution. The reason many of these scientists state as to why they believe in creation is, because it agrees with real science. The reason they state as to why they do not believe in evolution is, because there is no evidence of it. The facts speak for themselves, evolution is untenable and contrary to actual science, and doesn't even make common sense. Also the practice of trying to explain our world, not using facts and what nature tells us, but always the narrative that everything on earth took millions of years to "evolve". It seems obvious the Grand Canyon was formed

by the flood. **Genesis 7** tells us it rained forty days and forty nights, which caused a huge flood lasting 150 days. It may have taken just a few months to form the Grand Canyon. With massive amounts of water removing millions of cubic yards of rocks, and grinding them up into sand. Then depositing that sand over thousands of square miles of the Southwest United States, including the Mohave Desert. The "evidence" being witness to these events, giving us also the answers to two questions. 1-Where did all the material from the Grand Canyon go? 2-Where did all that sand come from? Who and what should we believe, an all powerful Creator and the evidence, or "scientists" lacking evidence. They only give us "theory" to come

to their final conclusion, "millions of years." **2nd Timothy 4:4** "and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables." The reality of an all powerful, all knowing God is evident in the creation as well as in the wisdom stated throughout the Bible **Psalm 33:4** "For the word of the Lord is right, And all His work is done in truth " The Dinosaurs: We have been told so many times that the Dinosaurs lived millions of years ago, and that about 65 million years ago they were destroyed by a huge meteor. When in fact, it is totally impossible to know anything that supposedly happened millions of years ago. We are still trying to discover events that happened just thousands of years ago.

Using DNA, archaeology and other scientific methods and evidence, and our conclusions are often changing still. We do have real known scientific facts, the known speed of light, DNA, atoms and much more. The known speed of light allows us to know the distance and approximate age of the stars and galaxies. It also tells us the fact that the universe is billions of years old. Latest scientific estimate on the age of the universe is 13-14 billion years? DNA tells us humans are diverse and unique to themselves and not the product of evolution. About 8 billion people on the earth, and science can identify each and every one, through their DNA. This is "evidence" to believe with common sense in the "creation" of humans and all of life.

139:13-14 "For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mothers womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well." Every human has been individually made by God, who knows and loves each and every one. Also, the word Dinosaur wasn't invented until 1842, so it cannot be in the Bible. God called them "behemoth" in **Job 40:15-24, Verse 15** "Look now at the behemoth," which I made along with you; He eats grass like an ox." God then goes on to describe it, and it sounds very much like a Brontosaurus? He just told us also, he made this creature at the same time he made humans. According to Genesis and the

genealogy from Adam, humans were made just thousands of years ago, which agrees also with the Hebrew calendar. The "flood" is mentioned in many writings of the different ancient civilizations Humans have been given so much misinformation and "theory" especially since the 1800's and Darwin's "theory of evolution", that the truth of the Bible is sometimes hard for some to come back to. When in fact the evidence and actual science support its truth. Were the Dinosaurs destroyed by a large meteor, 65 million years ago as these "scientist's" tell us? No, we can actually find their remains. And where do we find those remains? Buried in the earth, just where we would expect to find them after an overwhelming flood.

Should we believe the "theory" that we could find their skeleton's mostly intact after 65 million years? Sixty five million years of what would be earthquakes, tectonic plate upheaval's, floods etc? Totally absurd, and again with no evidence for a time line, only "theory". While scripture and the evidence give us the date of the flood to be around 4300+ years ago. Their "theory" is just another attempt by Satan through humanists, to discredit in the minds of humans God's Word. Which can not and will not happen despite their worst efforts. *Psalm* 119:160 "The entirety of Your word is truth, And every one of Your righteous judgments endures forever." Isaiah 40:8 "The grass withers, the flower fades, But the

word of our God stands forever." 1st Peter 1:25 "But the word of the Lord endures forever." Another proof of Bible truths, are the large deposits of oil found all around the earth. Early in Bible times it had not rained yet on the earth, but God tells us there was a mist everywhere. Humid conditions much like a jungle where everything would grow profusely. Genesis 2:1-7, Verse 6 "but a mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground." The word petroleum means, "rock oil", or "oil from the earth." Its made from vegetation, trees, plants, algae and micro organisms that have been buried. Then through heat, pressure and time, have turned into what we call oil. In Genesis chapters 1 through

6 is when all these things were made. Plants, trees, vegetation, algae, organisms etc. all over the earth, and in chapter 7 buried in the great flood. There is obvious heat and pressure generated during this process. It has been learned recently that it doesn't take very long to "make" petroleum. The U.S. Dept. of Energy's Pacific Northwest National Laboratory PNNL, proved this. They have invented a process that produces petroleum with harvested algae on the same day that wet algae is put under heat and pressure. Hence we could easily have petroleum being made, not over millions of years, but in hundreds or at most thousands of years. If the Bible narrative is true, then we would expect to find large deposits of

petroleum in many places on this young earth, which we certainly do. Atoms also, the foundation of everything witness to the truth of scripture. Everything in the universe is made from atoms, except light as far as we know, light is made from photons. Atoms are the simplest structural unit of an element and retain all the properties of that element. Atoms make up the 118 elements in our world, which in different combinations, "make" everything in the universe. There is a fundamental misunderstanding of scripture by some people in Genesis 1:1-31, Verse 1-2 "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the

deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters." The Bible states very clearly, this was the "beginning" of God's Creation. "Then" continues on in verses 3-31 with the six 24 hour days, (evening and morning) that God completed His Creation. "Then" means, at another time or at other times. Verses 2 and 3 are obviously separated by billions of years, because we know the universe is billions of years old. While the Bible's earth narrative intimates a young earth just thousands of years old, yet that had to be "made" from the original billions of years old atoms. Genesis 2:1 "Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished."

there are three heavens mentioned in the Bible. In Genesis 1:6-8, the Bible tells us about God making a firmament (atmosphere) to divide the waters which were under the firmament (atmosphere) from the waters which were above the firmament. And He called that firmament heaven, that is the first heaven. He speaks of the second heaven in Genesis 1:14-18, where the stars are And the third heaven (where God resides and Christians will be going to after their death) in 2nd Corinthians 12:2. The third heaven has always been, since God has always been, so it too is finished. We do not know where that heaven exists, inside or maybe outside the universe, only that it has existed and will exist forever.

2nd Corinthians 12:4, also speaks of a "Paradise." The "beginning" period of time in the creation is referred to as, "laying the foundation of the earth" in Zechariah 12:1, and also in Hebrews 1:10 "And: You, Lord, in the beginning, laid the foundation of the earth. And the heavens are the work of Your hands." Since the foundation of everything in the universe is atoms, it is in the "beginning" that God would have "created" all the atoms that would ever exist. During the next billions of years is when God would have "made" everything He wanted in His universe from those atoms. including stars, galaxy's, planets etc. It seems also that He "made" all of those from dark matter, because again as He tells

us in **Genesis 1:1-2** "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters." It was dark throughout the universe. Scientists today believe though we can't see dark matter, it exists, has mass, hence gravity. They also observe that there are gravitational forces acting on objects in space from what could be dark matter, which we can not see. It makes common sense, that God took much of that dark matter and "made" things He wanted, but there is still some of it left in space. After billions of years of "making" these things, He then "created" on the first of the 24 hour days, light.

He "lit up" those stars, sun and galaxy's. "Then" does mean at another time or at other times, used as a correlative with the now Genesis 1:3 "Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light," He also tells us in Genesis 1:2 "The earth was without form. and void;" This also agrees with the interpretation that the earth was "completed" at a much later time. For truth, we must interpret scripture honestly and accurately. Ignoring "theory," and some of the wrong "science" of this world. We discern the truth of what the Bible does and does not say. The Bible does not say the universe is only about 6,000 years old, which it clearly is not. The Bible recognizes the universe is billions of years old, also that the "completed" earth is

merely thousands of years old. But would still be made from atoms created billions of years ago. The more we read and study the Bible, the more we will realize how very true and factual it is. Not just about our surroundings and the creation, but also so true of humans, who they are, and who they can be. Christ came to earth in fully human form though He was God, and as such was the only perfect human ever on this earth. God has allowed imperfect humans to do His will on the earth, and still does so today. David committed adultery with Bathsheba, and though God punished him for that, David still did mighty things for God. David was also a direct ancestor of Jesus human side. Jacob was a deceiver, yet God blessed and renamed him

Israel, the name of His Bible lands. Saul of Tarsus was a persecuter of Christians and of "the way" as they called the Christian faith. He stood by approvingly as Stephen, the first martyr, was stoned to death. Acts 7: 54-60. Yet God showed him "the light" as we like to say these days, literally, on the Damascus road. God renamed him Paul, the greatest writer of scripture in the new testament, which has led untold millions to Christ. Renaming humans when they believe and accept Jesus Christ as their Savior, seems a type of metaphor for being "born again." Becoming a Christian enables us to be and do what we thought impossible. **Philippians** 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." The Hebrew word "bara" means

"created" out of nothing" and occurs about 50 times in the Bible. While "asah" means "made" out of something." Asah is used about 2600 times in the Bible. So while God has "created" many things, He has also "made" many things. This testifies that, after the initial "creation" of atoms, God was "making" things out of those atoms for billions of years. Things like stars, galaxy's planets, etc. The last and final thing he "made" was humans, "made" in His image" on the sixth day. He had also made hell, why? 2nd Peter 2:4-11 "For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment; and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah,

one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly; and turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes, condemned them to destruction. making them an example to those who afterward would live ungodly; and delivered righteous Lot, who was oppressed by the filthy conduct of the wicked (for that righteous man, dwelling among them, tormented his righteous soul from day to day by seeing and hearing their lawless deeds), then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment, and especially those who walk according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and

despise authority. They are presumptuous, self-willed. They are not afraid to speak evil of dignitaries, whereas angels, who are greater in power and might, do not bring a reviling accusation against them before the Lord." Satan was cast out of heaven: Revelation 12:7-9 "And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer. So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world: he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him." Lucifer was the most powerful and beautiful of all the angels, and is in fact Satan. He

was lifted up by his false pride and tried to be equal with God. And so was cast down to the earth, where he has been deceiving humans and destroying their lives ever since. A third of the angels were loyal to Lucifer, so were cast out of heaven with him. Now those angels are still with Satan and have become Satan's demons, helping the devil deceive humans around the world. Isaiah 14:12, "How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations!" Luke 10:18 "And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven." Ephesians 6:12, tells us our fight is a spiritual fight against these powers. God just told us also that the serpent of

old in the "Garden of Eden" who tempted Adam and Eve to sin, was this Satan. So yes, God did create a place of judgment called hell. Matthew 25:41 "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, "Depart from me you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: God just told us, He has prepared the fire of hell for the devil and his angels. **Jeremiah 9:23-24** "Thus says the Lord: "Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, Let not the mighty man glory in his might, Nor let the rich man glory in his riches; But let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, That I am the Lord, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight" says the Lord."

That is why He created hell. Because He is Holy and Righteous and hates sin. Yes God, the God of love hates one thing, sin. He will not allow any sin, of any kind, to enter His realm of heaven, where He abides. He cannot even look at sin, much less abide it. Just as He had to look away from His precious Son Jesus Christ, when Christ took all our sins and the sins of the whole world upon Himself, and was dving on the cruel cross of Calvary. When Jesus cried out.

Mark 15:34 "And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani? Which is translated, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" God never has and never will send any human to hell. Humans choose their own

fate, heaven or hell, when we accept or reject Jesus Christ as our Savior. John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." 1st John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Romans 8:38-39 "For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ our Lord." The nation of Israel and most of the Jewish people rejected Jesus Christ (Anointed Messiah),

and have suffered the harsh consequence. No people on earth have suffered more or been discriminated against more than the Jewish people. As Christians, we are to love and pray for the Jewish people, and the nation of Israel. **Psalm 122:6** "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem:" Romans 3:1-2 "What advantage then has the Jew, or what is the profit of circumcision? Much in every way! Chiefly because to

then has the Jew, or what is the profit of circumcision? Much in every way! Chiefly because to them were committed the oracles of God." Including Isaiah 53. Through them, came our Savior Jesus Christ (Anointed Messiah), and the Bible. God had told them, Deuteronomy 28, That if they would follow Him as their true and only God, they would be blessed, and if not they would be

cursed. Predictably the Jewish people failed to follow God faithfully. They were a, Acts 7:51 "stiff necked and resistant people," despite all that God had given them. That is one reason some still ignorantly call the Jewish people, "the Christ killers." When in fact, all of humanity has sinned, and together have brought about the cross and Christ's atoning death on that cross. Some people may feel they've done too many wrong things to ever have a chance to get to heaven, but that is not true. Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." There are no sins that would ever prevent God from loving and forgiving anyone. Romans 5:8, "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we

were still sinners, Christ died for us." Being forgiven of our sin isn't just saying the words, "Dear God, I have sinned, please forgive me in Jesus name." Rather it must be a heartfelt recognition that we truly are a sinner. Knowing that we have done things that our conscience tells us were wrong. Or have not done things we know we should have done. God has created a conscience in every human being for that very purpose. God's Holy Spirit speaks to our conscience to guide us humans in our lives. We all sin, then are to sincerely ask our Creators forgiveness, in the name of His Son, Jesus Christ. Then prove our sincerity by repenting of our sins, and make the necessary changes to our lives. And though our lives, like everyone

else's, will never be perfect, we never stop trying. Every human also has Satan and his demon's trying to influence them to not listen to God, and to do things contrary to God's way. **Proverbs 6:16** "These six things the Lord hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood, A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil, A false witness who speaks lies. And one who sows discord among brethren." Pride is listed as the first sin God hates, and that is the sin Lucifer, the most powerful and beautiful of all the angels committed. He was lifted up by that false pride, which caused him to try to be equal with God. That pride is different than the pride one feels

for their children, or of a job honorably done. God also seems to detest the sin of someone thinking they are better than someone else in some way. Things like their color, race, beauty, or the handicapped. Things they have no control over and were determined when they were in their mothers womb. **Psalm 139:13-14** "For you formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mothers womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are your works, And that my soul knows very well." Jesus Christ Himself was neither white or black, but middle eastern, being His earthly mother was Jewish. What we do know is, that there are Christians of every color, race, and ethnicity, and that God

loves each and every one equally. **Acts 10:34** "Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality."

However, where humans live, their life experience's, what faith or lack of faith of their family's, and other factors, do have influence on their final destination, heaven or hell. That is why **Psalm 19:1-4**, is so important and bears repeating, "The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no speech nor language Where their voice is not heard. Their line has gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world." Every nation's peoples can relate to this awesome Creation, that shows a Designer and Creator. The Middle East where Christ was born, and Abraham is the patriarch of Jewish, Christian and Islam faiths. Though Christianity is not a religion, it is a relationship with God's only Son, Jesus Christ. Who is personal to each and every human that invites Him into their life. He is part of the trinity with God and the Holy Spirit, and speaks to God on our behalf. 1st Timothy 2:5 "For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus." Americans are the most blessed people on earth. Not because we are inherently any better than any other nation or people. But rather it is because America was founded on Judeo-

Christian values, then blessed by God in every way. While Israel and the Jewish people are God's chosen nation and people for His plan of salvation for the whole world, through Jesus Christ. Genesis 15:18 "On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying: "To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates." All land between the Nile and Euphrates rivers. The Jewish people retain possession of just a small portion of that land today. Again, *Romans* 3:1-2, "What advantage then has the Jew, or what is the profit of circumcision? Much in every way! Chiefly because to them were committed the oracles of God," which included Isaiah 53. Israel

and America are two nations ordained by God. Nations that turn away from God, Hosea 5:4-6 "will stumble, and seek but not find Him:". America is and has been turning away from God much too long. Recent events show America certainly is "stumbling". Though America has done more than any other nation to bring God's truths to the whole world, it is losing those beliefs and values more each day it seems. Some large denomination churches bear some of the responsibility for this, as they do not preach from the Bible. But rather give the "prosperity gospel" and the "feel good" messages. Instead of true Bible messages that all humans need to hear to be reconciled to God. 2nd Timothy 4:3-4 For the time will come when

they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables." Some messages of truth straight from God's Word are; The truth of sin, and that all humans are sinners. The truth of heaven and hell, that each and every human ever conceived will eventually be in one or the other. Truth that we have a loving Creator who will forgive any sinner who honestly admits they are a sinner, asks for forgiveness through His Son Jesus Christ, and that then repent. These "tough love" truths from the Bible, speak to the very souls of human beings. They are the truths that can and do inform and convict humans of their sin. When we come to the conclusion we are a sinner, it is not the Bible's, hence God's way, to confess our sins to a priest or pastor, or any other human being. Because they cannot do anything about our sins. They cannot forgive them, and they cannot intercede to God for our sins. God tells us, we are to confess our sins to God (Jesus Christ) and Him alone. The matter of each human being forgiven of their sins, is a personal matter between that person and God. We have probably all noticed some people in our lives that seem different from most. Who seem kinder, more concerned and compassionate towards other human beings. We can't really put our finger on what it is about them

that makes them different. Because they, like many others may keep their relationship with God more private, their prayers, good deeds etc. They do not wear God on their sleeves so to speak. And are the ones who do the will of God, not just talk about it, they please God this way. *Matthew 7:21 "Not* everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord', shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven." God does want us to use our lives as a witness to His life transforming message, and to spread His truth of the gospel this way. Every person when they accept Christ as their Savior and are "born again", receive a "gift" from God. There are many gifts, the gift of preaching, or of teaching, the gift of helps,

of discernment and many others. We are to use whatever gift God has given us to help humans find His truths and their way to heaven. Leaving aside the worlds ways and our sins as best we can. God given common sense, and a God given conscience, should be enough to convince humans of the truth of the Bible. Also nature and the way things actually are, should leave no doubt of a Designer and Creator of it all period. Nature and the millions of different life forms, with not just some, but all of them showing design and purpose. The fact that "evolution" with its "random selection" being totally incapable of producing any of it. Also no "evidence" for their "theory", just "theory" built upon other "theory's". This may seem a harsh

assessment of the "theory of evolution," but no more than it deserves. The evidence of "love" in our universe, speaks of a loving "Creator God." Who knows and understands all aspects of humans, because He made them. Also the fact of the other emotions, hate, jealousy, temper etc. not possibly explained by evolution. Add to the emotions, the senses, instinct and the many other abilities. "Theory of evolution" is both, scientifically untenable and deceiving. So humanists need to either try to discredit the Bible, or if the Bible is true, admit to sin if they want to have the life God tells them they could have. The human nature is too strong in some to allow them to do that. The lusts of the flesh, overpowering the will to do right.

Though God has created both human nature and the spiritual nature in humans. He has also created enough evidence of the spiritual, short of creating robots, for all to believe. The entire universe showing design, purpose, wisdom and power of a Designer and Creator. He has also created a place called hell, something many humans reject. *Isaiah 55:8-9 "For* My thoughts are not your your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways", says the Lord. "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways, And My thoughts than your thoughts." There are obviously different levels in hell, perhaps in heaven as well. Revelation 21:8 "But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually

immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death." Does this mean that if someone told a lie they would go to hell? Obviously not or we would probably all be in hell. A liar is someone who habitually lies about everything and deceives and hurts others for gain. There is also for those who ask, forgiveness with God. Christians may pray the Lords prayer every day for their sins which were unintentional. "Our Father which art in heaven. Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against

us And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, forever and ever, Amen." We can do nothing to earn our way into heaven, but only believe and accept God's truths. Great preacher, J. Vernon McGee, put it like this, "Hebrews 11 has come down through the ages as the "Hall of Faith" chapter in the Bible. It chronicles the lives of people, many well known, others obscure, who changed the world by believing God. These are stories of people who not only walked a road less traveled, but who traveled an altogether different route. They walked by faith, the way God wants all of us to walk each day. Hebrews 11 offers several examples of real people

who lived their lives by believing in the truth of God, even though it couldn't be seen. These faithful people laid the foundation for trusting God, and ultimately paved the way for Messiah, God's promised Deliverer. They believed God, and for them it was not a leap in the dark nor a false sense of hope. Their faith rested on evidence. Noah built an ark, and he did it by faith. What kind of faith? Was it just some dream he had? No. God gave him an abundance of evidence because Noah had trusted God's message for many years. Abraham shines as another credible example. Though he had never known or seen God, once he encountered God's voice and call, he believed Him. He put his faith in God. When Abraham believed,

God granted him righteousness. He made him new (Genesis 15:6). Abraham received true righteousness, not because of his stellar life, but because he believed God. Faith helps us grasp the origins of the universe, too. God commanded the world and the entire universe into existence That's what is revealed in the Bible. It is faith that allows us to accept that truth. In the case of Abel, Adam and Eve's son, God made it clear that people must approach Him on only one basis: by faith. In other words, Abel and all other individuals after him could find favor with God when they trusted Him, demonstrated faith in His Word. Abel had apparently received a revelation from God So did Cain. They were both in the

same family. But Cain ignored God's command and did his own thing, bringing the fruit of the ground, or crops, that he had produced. In other words, here is the first man who brought his works to God. A lot of people today try to make themselves right with God the same way, by presenting their own good deeds or by relying on their own resourcefulness. Abel, on the other hand, brought a sacrifice of a lamb, as God had commanded. He shed the blood of the lamb, signifying the shed blood of Jesus, and trusted God's Word. His offering pointed to Jesus, and he responded to God's command by faith. Abel illustrates to us the way of faith, it is the blood sprinkled way, the way that is Christ. Another example was

Enoch, an old testament individual who also lived by faith in God's Word. But most unusually, Enoch apparently did not die. He was simply translated into God's presence. But prior to that, he believed God after his son Methuselah was born. We don't know what God said to Enoch, but he trusted Him regardless. And it became for him eternal life **Genesis 5** records Enoch's mysterious story. And its a relatively sad story to be sure. Many peoples story's are sad, representing a life filled with heartache, disappointment, loneliness, and loss. Maybe you feel your life is made of endless sad chapters with no end in sight. If so, Enoch's story is for you. Because despite all that sadness,

God revealed Himself to this man and Enoch believed Him. **Genesis 5** also records the generations of Adam. Line after line reveals that one of Adam's sons had his own son and those sons had sons and on and on it went. Eventually, every one of them died. That's what happens in the human experience. No one lives forever. Eventually, people die. Some die prematurely, others at the end of a long adventurous, or at times, tortured life. Its the story of humanity. Faith makes all the difference in our relating to God. You simply cannot live a good enough life to please God and find His favor. What pleases God is when you believe Him. When you put your faith in what He has revealed. If you want to come to

God and be found acceptable to Him, you must believe that He exists and that He is who He claims to be in His Word Do you believe God? This might be a good time for you to reflect on what it is that you are trusting for your life's purpose and direction. You may believe in yourself. In your dream. In your own resourcefulness, perhaps your intellect or charm. None of that adds up to eternal life or to a life of meaning and genuine fulfillment. That only leads to emptiness and ultimately death, and an eternity apart from God. God always rewards anyone who responds to Him or seeks Him with faith in their heart. Faith is what prompts God to offer life" **Hebrews 11:6** "But without faith it is impossible to

please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him." God tells us very plainly that the way to get to heaven, is to believe that He is, and to act on those beliefs. The way to get to hell, is to not believe that He is, and do nothing. God tells us three times, in Matthew 24:35, Mark 13:31, Luke 21:31, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away." God provides every human with a temporary physical life, in which we are to seek God's way to our everlasting life in heaven, through Jesus and the gospel. John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him

should not perish but have everlasting life."

1st Corinthians 15:1-4 Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which you are saved, If you hold fast that word which I preached to you, unless vou believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures." The scriptures seem to tell us, there are different levels in hell. The deepest level where there is "fire and brimstone." Also a level where most of lost humanity will probably go, where there will be

"weeping and gnashing of teeth," All humans have eternal life, some in heaven and some in hell. With, it seems, a great gulf between those two places. The deepest part of hell for the very worst. Others there, like in the rich man and Lazarus story, will be able to look across that great gulf and see what they could have had, thus will be in misery. But the ones in heaven with God will not be aware of or be able to see across that great gulf, to realize who is there. This involves some speculation, because we do not know how hell actually is, we just know that it is a reality. We look to the scriptures for it all, and the best description of it seems to be in the story of the rich man and Lazarus in *Luke 16:19-31*. Where a rich man died and went to hell,

and a poor man died and went to heaven. Rich people are again mentioned in *Matthew 19:24, "And again I say unto you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."*

Riches and the rich are mentioned many times in the Bible. Perhaps to emphasize that riches are temporary and will soon pass away, and can't be compared to eternal life in heaven. This also reminds us that there are sins of omission, as well as of commission. That with riches come responsibility, to make provision for the preaching of the gospel, care for the poor etc. Many rich certainly do that, but the ones who don't will be judged. The fire and brimstone is prepared for the devil and his

demons. It may also be true for the many truly evil and wicked humans who have lived throughout history. Ones like Hitler, Stalin and others who've caused much suffering, death and disbelief, which helped send many souls to hell. There would seem to be different levels in heaven also. The four gospel writers Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, and the writers of the old and new testaments. The many millions of humans who have believed God and helped lead others to God and His Son, Jesus Christ. Also all the children, every child who has ever been conceived. Those who never made it out of the womb alive, or died soon after being born. The many children who have died at a young age. These will all be, or are in heaven right now.

Matthew 19:13-14 "Then little children were brought to Him that He might put His hands on them and pray, but the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them, for of such is the kingdom of heaven." God has a plan for all of the many precious to Him souls that will be in heaven. It's just that in our human minds it would seem to be at different levels. It's a fact that some have done more for the kingdom, or have gotten more rewards, but again we do not know how that affects where God places them in His kingdom. It may be hard for them to find His truths, and they most probably will be persecuted for believing those truths. As a favorite Christian song reminds us, "It will be worth it all, when we see Jesus." Christians all over the world pray that these people and all others of different faiths, will find and accept Jesus Christ as their Savior.
